Area of Difficulty/Improvement	Students are underprepared for the discussion in class
Description of the Difficulty/ Need for improvement	Students forget very quickly the learnings and takeaways from each session of a course. Most students are new to finance and are not able to process all takeaway from a session immediately and need to revisit the learnings soon after the class. Inability to assimilate new learnings also impacts the takeaways from subsequent sessions that build on prior concepts.
Innovation Name	Daily Warm-up Quiz
Description of the Innovation	A short warm-up quiz of 2/ 3 minute duration at the beginning of the class on the key takeaways of the previous session and/or on the pre-readings for the current session. The idea was to gamify the learning by creating high student involvement with low stakes – In all, about 18 quizzes of 2/3 questions each were administered using the student portal with maximum marks limited to 5.
Learning Outcomes	<p>The students revise the learnings from the previous session in anticipation of the quiz.</p> <p>The students are better prepared for a class discussion for the upcoming class.</p>

Other significant outcomes	The students learn that to think of what is truly the most important learning of a particular session and also learn how to be disciplined with their course-related journey.
